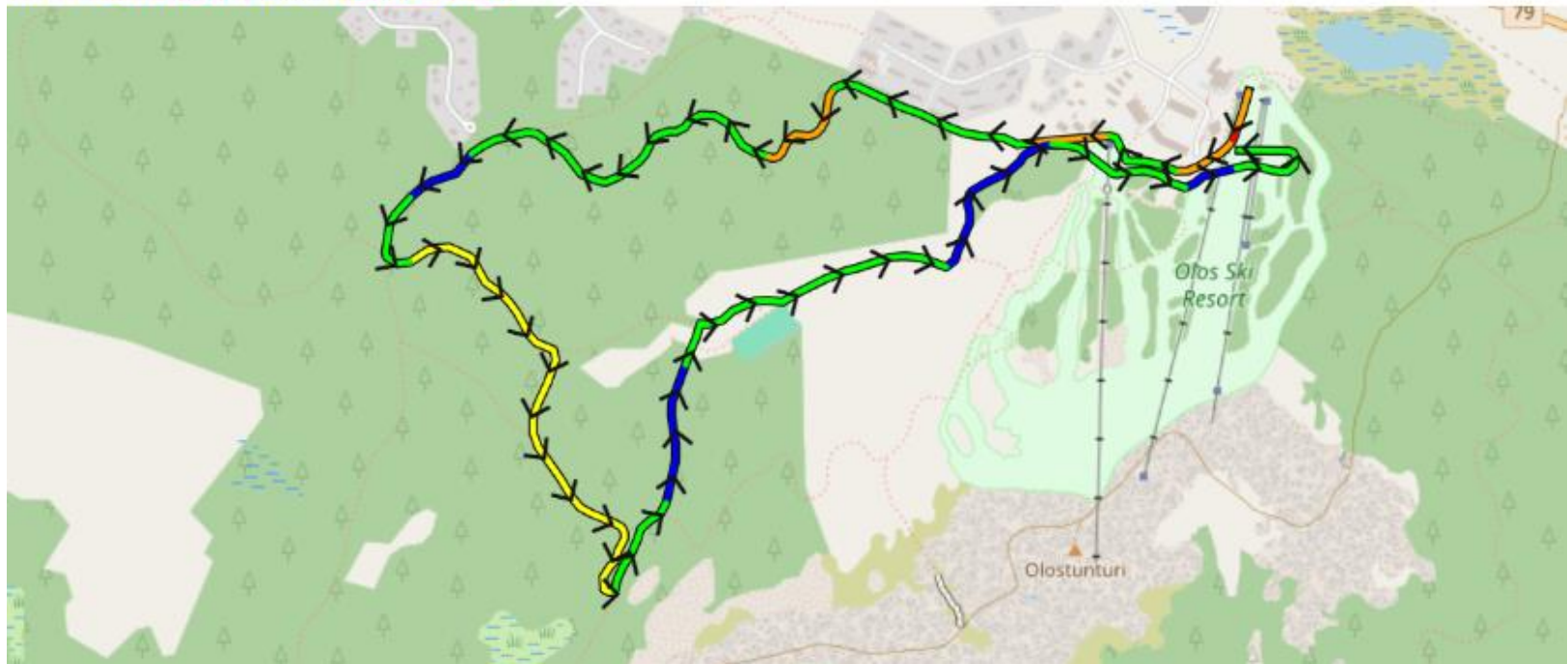

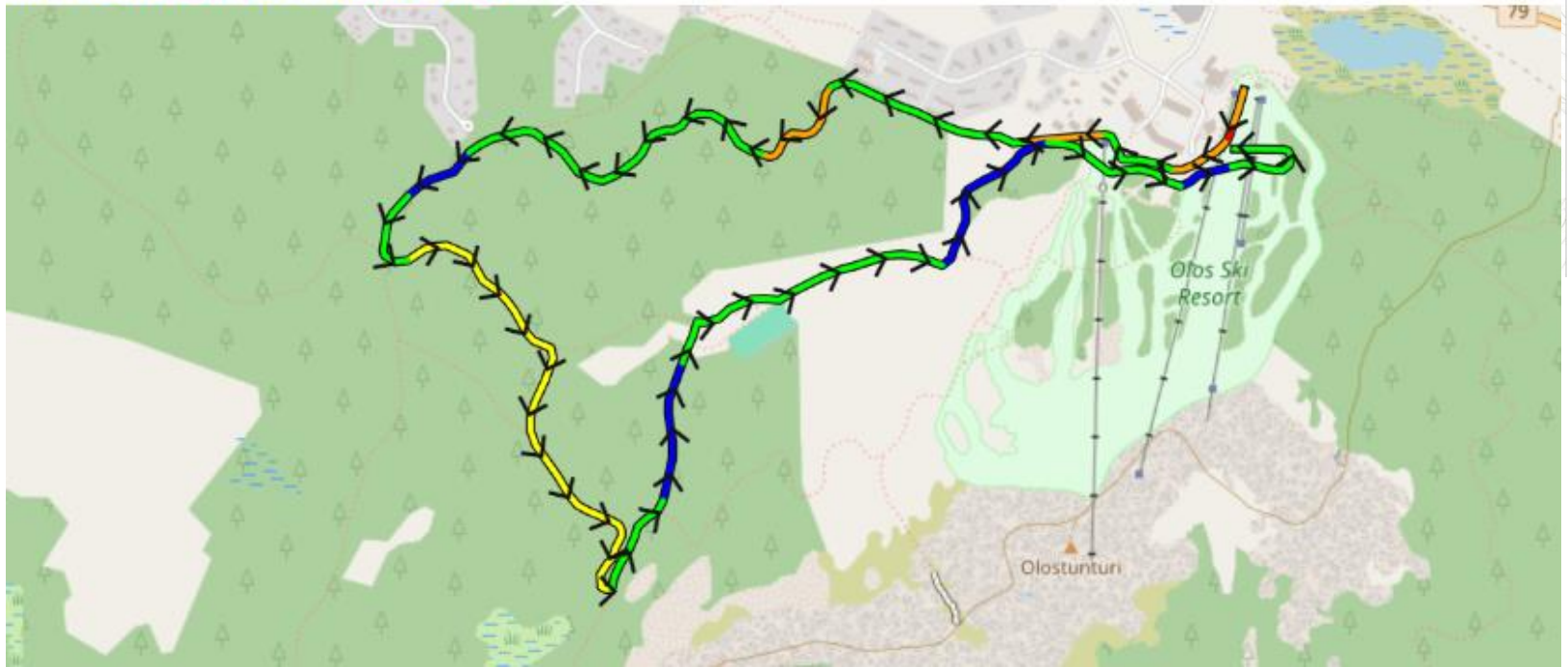

General information from the TD

- * Fair and safe competitions
 - * During sprints, avoiding obstructions by passing others
 - * During individual start, give free way on first command
- * Skiing in the right direction, also apply on coaches
- * Pay attention – use classical technique during classical race (also for coaches and servicemens)
- * Respect the opening/closing times of the track
- * Good luck – looking forward to begin the season

ICR Update

Protests after sprint finals

325.6.2 Due to the timeline pressure of running successive heats it is not possible to allow protests during quarterfinals and semi-finals. Protests will only be accepted **after on the finals heats**.

361.2.3 Protests against Jury decisions **that cannot be appealed** (art. 224.11) will not be accepted.

ICR Updates

Leaving the marked course

343.6 Competitors must follow the marked course in correct sequence from start to finish and must pass all control points*.

~~343.6.1 If competitors skis on a wrong section or leaves the marked course, the competitor should return to the point where the error was made. In order to do so, the competitor may have to ski against the correct ski direction and shall be totally responsible for ensuring that there is no obstruction and that other competitors are not endangered.~~

NOTE

** A competitor making a mistake can correct by returning to the point where the mistake was made. If he/she does that, he/she is responsible for ensuring that there is no obstruction and that other competitors are not endangered.*

General information from the Organiser

- * As stated by the Finnish Ski Association, fluorinated wax will be tested with a testing device at the Olos Tykkikisat in 2025.
- * Test cabin is located at the start – before the start time
- * Test opportunity after the race of Friday and Saturday is located close the start area (same cabin)

Qualification

- * Skis will collect and marked by organiser after the finish
- * Tested skis can be pick up nearby the Fluor testing area
- * If you have FIS and/or Suomen Cup or other stickers from earlier races, PLEASE CLEAN those

Finals

Athletes can use one pair of skis during finals. It is not allowed to change the skis between heats.

There will be the possibility to fix the grip wax between heats (one ski service person/athlete), in controlled area nearby the start

Skis will collect and marked by organiser after the finish the heats. Organisers will carry the skis to start area.

Those which not qualified, skis will test immediately and picked up nearby fluortest facilities
